1410/11 Parking Provision

Cllr J. Kemp updated Council on parking issues raised with the Highways Department at North Lincolnshire Council:

- Residents on West Street should report occasions when a vehicle is blocking their driveway on the 101 number. For one resident in particular who is having ongoing problems, it was advised that they could contact the Highways Department direct, as Highways may be able to send an officer from Enforcement straight away.
- Earlsgate. A variety of measures was looked into at the time of introducing the speed restrictors. Results show these have reduced the speed considerably and that no further measures are required.
- The Pensioner Bungalows on De-Lacy way are to have 5 additional parking bays, through North Lincolnshire Homes, to ease parking problems.
- Highways have looked at various options for Northlands Road to reduce speed and ease parking problems, including parking bays. This however, would reduce the number of parking spaces available. The current parking provision also works as a speed restrictor, and slows the flow of traffic down.

b. The Council considered the appointment of members to a Working Party to consider Parking Provision in the Town.
