Council agreed to move point 7c CCTV Provision, to discuss the matter with the Ward Councillors.
Resolution: A meeting to be arranged with NLC, Ward Councillors and the Property Committee to discuss the location of the CCTV Cameras and discuss the Councils concern over the lack of coverage for West Street Park.

- 1411/7 Police Matters
The following matters were discussed:
a. Cllr B. Bridge reported from the NATS meeting on the 30th October 2014. Humberside Police are introducing changes to policing to increase the number of Police Officers on the streets whilst saving money. The Police Officers that were based in Winterton are now based at the Barton Police Station. At the moment, there are no plans to sell the Winterton Police Station
b. Reports of antisocial behavior in and around West Street Park, the High Street and Northlands Road were reported. It was stressed how important it is that these incidents and others must be reported to the Police using the 101 number.
c. The Chair read out an email from Cllr J. Kemp regarding the locations of the new CCTV equipment.
d. No other matters were discussed.

- 1411/8 Youth Provision
Cllr F. Marritt asked Council to consider commissioning a survey to establish what young people in the town want. In recent months we have seen an increase in low level vandalism, and anti-social behavior due to a lack of Youth Provision in the Town.
Council recommended it employ a Youth Worker on a temporary basis to engage with the younger community and report to Council with recommendations for future provision in 2015/2016.
Resolution: Personnel Committee advertise post and recruitment suitable candidate.

ACTION: Personnel Committee and Acting Clerk.

1411/9 Winterton 2022

Council was informed that a meeting with Winterton 2022 was to take place on Thursday 20th November. A report on the meeting between representatives of the Council and Winterton 2022 working in partnership to progress community projects will be given at the December Full Council Meeting.

1411/10 Winterton Community Pavilion

Cllrs F. Fletcher and F. Marritt declared Prejudicial Interests and left the room for Agenda items 1411/10 a,b,c. Cllr L. Langton declared a Prejudicial Interest and left the room for Agenda items 1411/10 b and c.

a. It was reported that:

- A meeting took place between the WPFA and Chris Whitelock from Pure Renewables on the 19th November and that the WPFA now have the relevant information for the reclaim.
- The Fire Alarm has gone off again over the weekend

b. The Council discussed the matters raised above.

c. In accordance with minute 1410/14 members had been sent a design of a possible Dale Park Football Club sign for the gable end of the pavilion. Members decided the dimensions were too large and that any signage needed to reflect that the building is a community pavilion with many users. Therefore the Council resolved that:

- a) A large sign solely for Dale Park Football Club is inappropriate and therefore the proposed sign was not approved.
- b) Signage on the gable end of the pavilion is acceptable but the most prominent display must be the words 'Winterton Community Pavilion' and include the town's logo.
- c) There can be additional signage to advertise the users of the pavilion such as Dale Park Football Club.
- d) The Council shall work with the Playing Fields Association, as the tenants of the pavilion, to agree and erect a suitable design.

Resolution: Quotes to be obtained for the new signage and designs for the user board to be sourced and put to Council when available.

ACTION: Acting Clerk
