The following matters were raised by/on behalf of members of the public:

1. The lamppost on Manlake Avenue across from the doctor's surgery still hasn't been replaced.
2. The Disabled Club is holding a Charity Fair on Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> April from 1.30pm at the Methodist Chapel.
3. The Council received an update on the numbers of survivors for both the WW1 and WW2 and was shown a photograph of the late Walter Dixon.
4. It was reported that the area around the Church and Churchside has seen an increase in anti-social behavior. All matters have been reported to the Police.
5. A local family highlighted to the Council the different criteria for IVF treatment depending on your local and the NHS Trust you come under. Some families are allowed up to 3 attempts on the NHS, whilst other area are only allowed 1 attempt.

- 1504/06 Police Matters  
Cllr B. Bridge reported on the NATs meeting held prior to the Council meeting.  
A representative from Humberside Police Anti-Social Behavior Team attended the meeting to highlight changes to Anti-Social Behavior orders, including civic injunctions and Dispersal notices. Information on these changes will be sent to the Clerk for distribution. The group was also made aware that PC Amanda Barnett now has a larger area to cover and is operating from the Police Station in Barton.
