1305/1 **Presentation by Mayor**

Cllr F. Marritt, Mayor of Winterton Town Council made a brief presentation on the work of the Council in the previous year. (*Attached*)

1305/2 **Minutes of Previous Meeting**

1305/3 **Awards**

a. **Burgon Award** – *For outstanding voluntary service to the community.*

The Burgon Award was presented jointly to Mrs Nicki Mumby and Ms Estelle Mumby who were thanked for all that they have under-taken for the Winterton Community.

b. **Don Johnson Youth Award** - *For outstanding voluntary service to the community by a person under 18 years of age.*

The Town was informed that the Council will present the Don Johnson Youth Award at the June Meeting of Full Council due to the recipients not being available due to exams and other commitments.

c. **Certificates of Appreciation** - *For outstanding voluntary service to the community.*
A Certificate of Appreciation was presented to Mr Jim Harding (collected in his absence by Mr Chris Pick).

1305/4 **Public Comment**

The following matters were raised by/on behalf of Members of the public:

1. The Clerk was thanked for her assistance in collating information over the past few months.
2. It was confirmed that Gladson Hall is owned by North Lincs. Council and the Old School Hall and Winterton Community Pavilion are owned by the Town Council but managed under lease by other bodies.
3. A question was asked about the level of Precept and this was responded to, the explanation given detailing the national formula and the role-on effects on the town's tax base.
4. The following matters relating to the Pavilion/WPFA were discussed:
 - It was asked if the Winterton Community Pavilion will have built in air conditioning and it was reported that there will be no need for this.
 - It was further confirmed that the Winterton Playing Field Association will be responsible for the setting of the Pavilion and Playing Field hire charges as per their lease, however, it was agreed that these would be 'reasonable'.
 - It was confirmed that a 20 year heating grant will be in place at the Community Pavilion which will subsidise running costs.

- The Pavilion will not be licenced (for the sale of alcohol) but will be able to apply for individual licenses as required.
 - The Winterton Playing Field Association AGM will take place at 8pm on 20/6/13 at the Jubilee Club, Churchside, Winterton
5. It was confirmed that Winterton will be entering the 2013 CPRE Best Kept Village competition. The Clerk was asked to speak with NLC Grounds Maintenance prior to judging about the poor state of the grass verges.
 6. Thanks were given to Cllr F. Marritt, Mayor of Winterton, for her service over the past two years and to PC Amanda Barnett and PCSO's Tara and Sarah.
 7. It was further confirmed that the Town Council are looking at the town's CCTV provision, including the Pavilion and other sites, over the coming months.
