North Lincolnshire Council will offer to install an automatic vehicle barrier across the existing entrance to the Winterton Town Council car park from the school drive. This proposal would be operated at peak traffic times (school pick up and drop-off points) and any other times the Town Council would like to use it

The benefit of installing the barrier is that it will minimise any current or new problems arising from pedestrians and vehicles using the same area. The offer also includes the installation of a pedestrian ('zebra') crossing and delineated walkway across the Town Council car park together with the creation of a suitable pedestrian route into the proposed North Lincolnshire Council owned and operated facilities (Library, Local Link and Gym). This, we believe, would offer more safety to children.

In return, North Lincolnshire Council asks that Winterton Town Council grant permission for the work described above to be implemented, together with the right for pedestrians to access the proposed North Lincolnshire Council owned and operated facilities (Library, Local Link and Gym) over Winterton Town Council car park.
