Gimp - FREE software similar to Photoshop used for editing photographs. We will be looking at:
Downloading the FREE Gimp package.
Using Gimp to edit photographs on your computer - cropping, enhancing and removing blotches on your photos. We will also save finished photos to a camera memory chip for printing at commercial outlets.

OpenOffice – FREE software similar to Microsoft Office with many uses such as Poster design (advertise goods for sale or community events), making cards, presentations, letter writing and much much more.

Open session – individual questions and problems.
