- Following residents from North Street contacting us re the verges encroaching on to the footpath on North Street, we have asked for this to be cleared. Works have been instructed.
- Residents on Low Street contacted us re the footpath that runs from Roxby to the Alps learning centre. We asked that the encroaching verge on to the footpath can be cleared so widening the footpath, making it safer for pedestrians. This has been carried out as a matter of urgency.
- Following resident's contact, we have asked for Park Street from Crakedale towards the Showground to be speed monitored. The last speed monitoring took place in December 2015. We have asked for this to be carried out again. This will be done late November /early December for 7 day monitoring. We have also asked for a police presence in an evening. Police advice is if particularly excessive speeds are happening regularly please log it with the 101 number so that the Police can build an accurate picture.
- Residents on Walker Drive are very concerned that due to inconsiderate parking emergency vehicles may not get access. We have asked highways officer to do a leaflet drop about taking due care and attention whilst parking.
- Parking on Market Hill has been raised to us, and the dangers of overtaking parked cars on the blind bend. The highways officers have said that they will look into this and the possibility of double yellow lines. Mindful, though, that this moves the problem elsewhere.
- We raised the Fly tipping on Marmion Drive to the environmental team and we asked for the 3 piece suite and other furniture to be removed.
