Changes to Speed limit for North Street consultation closes on 19th April for changes to speed limit.

Potholes – A1077

Safer Neighbourhoods Drop in

We have made enquiries re the CCTV on the Marmion Road area, as many residents have expressed grave concerns on anti-social behaviour, drugs related crime and residents being intimidated by groups. We have arranged to meet with the Safer Neighbourhoods Team and local policing team before the NATs meeting tomorrow on site to discuss issues.
