We are pleased to tell you about the investments we supported that have been secured for families and communities.

### **Communities**

- More than £5,000,000 invested over the next two years to replace street lights with the more energy and cost efficient LED street lights. Work in Winterton will be completed in the first year. Unlike other Councils no light will be dimmed or turned off
- Free 2 hour car parking in the week and all day free on a Saturday across North Lincolnshire Council car parks has been protected. Encouraging people to shop and use businesses locally.
- The Market Investments moving the current market into the old BHS building has been met with very positive feedback. Traders and shoppers alike have said how pleased they are at the news that the market is to be protected and that they can keep trading until the new site is completed.
- The traditional shop front grants have been protected for shops and businesses in conservation areas, to enhance their frontage to make them more welcoming encouraging visitor and shoppers. The George Hogg has already benefitted from this grant.

### **Adults, Children and Families**

- Imagination Library funding has been protected again. Providing free books monthly from birth to 5 years old. There are 465 families in the Winterton area who already benefit from this scheme and more signing up regularly.
- Post 16 transport kept low at £30 per year. Supporting students to remain in education attending colleges in North Lincolnshire.
- And for the older generation, an investment of £723,000 has been secured for Telecare over the next 4 years. This will help to keep the older generation independent and in their own homes.
