- **Dog bins**

We were contacted by a resident complaining about lack of dog bins in Winterton. There are 16 dog bins that are serviced by North Lincolnshire council throughout the town. Would it be possible for the Town Council to let us know how many dog bins they provide and service, so that we may go back to the resident with that information.

- **Planning**

- We have asked that PA/2018/1759 - Planning permission to erect 40 dwellings (including 32 affordable dwellings) and associated access, open space and drainage infrastructure on land to the south of Coates Avenue, Winterton, be determined by the planning committee

We have also asked the strategic planning officers that the land is removed from the local plan, when this is next considered in June 2019.

- We have requested regular updates on the archaeological dig on the Keigar site off Cemetery Road and North Street. There has been some trespass and vandalism of the site and Keigar's have secured the site to prevent this happening further. The Historic Environmental Officer meets on site on a weekly basis.

- **Leisure Consultation**

A leisure consultation held at Winterton Rangers was well attended. A good representation across all ages and abilities. The consultation responses will be looked at to see how the services can best be tailored to the service users' request.

- **Bus Passes**

We are also pleased to report that the free bus pass for older and disabled residents has been protected in North Lincolnshire. We have asked that residents will be able to apply for the bus pass at Winterton Library. We will let you know as soon as this is possible.

- **Call Connect**

The call connect bus is being well used in the area. A new regular use by residents going to Marks and Spencer shopping park is proving popular.

- **Post 16 Student travel**

In addition the Post 16 Student travel pass has been protected again at £30 for students attending colleges in North Lincolnshire. We know that young people are sometimes late to register for courses at North Lincolnshire based colleges, however this does not mean you won't be available to access the travel pass.
