## **ROXBY LANDFILL SITE UPDATE**

Dear Local Residents

I would like to provide you with an update on the ongoing works at Roxby Landfill.

We will be installing a further 90 to 100 gas extraction pin wells and additional 600m of scavenger lines into the newly tipped waste in Phase 12 on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> November enabling the gas extraction system to target multiple levels within the waste mass, therefore increasing the overall gas extraction of Landfill gas and the sustainable generation of electricity for the National Grid.

During these works we will endeavour to control any odours with the installation of an additional portable de-odouriser system which will be positioned at the drilling works location. All the drilled sections will also be capped and sealed at the end of each operational day to prevent any associated odours escape.

The above works will then allow the site to deploy an additional 15,000m<sup>2</sup> of capping onto Phase 12; which comprises welded LLDPE plastic in readiness for the festive period. We endeavour to complete these works by the 18<sup>th</sup> December 2020.

I would like to take this opportunity to update you on two local projects, through the Landfill Communities Fund Scheme, Biffa is able to divert landfill tax money into community projects.

Biffa Award has provided £74,600 to Winterton Bowling & Recreation Club for a new timber framed club house and £70,000 for the replacement of dilapidated play equipment to the War Memorial Playing Fields in Gainsborough.
