

Anyone who does not have photo id will be able to register for a Voters' certificate. This is applied for online ...wellbeing hubs can help or would encourage family members to help. This must be applied for by 25th April.

The Community Grant Team at NLC had advised the Poirier Foundation that they could apply for a community grant to pay for the Warm Safe Spaces and provided them with the forms and advice to do so. To date they had not received an application form the Poirier Foundation.
